

## • Balcony Beginner

### *French Beans – Purple Speck*



The green beans have purple markings. The seeds are white in color with few small black spots. A long duration crop of 75 days, for food production only. Highly productive and does well in cool climates.

Yield per hectare: 12t

### *Amaranth - Tricolor*



A black seeded variety of amaranth (keerai) cultivated mainly for its leaves. The abundant leaves are red-purple on the inside with an outer green margin. The plant has a beautiful inflorescence, vigorous growth, and can reach 2 m in height. The leaves of this variety are large and extremely nutritious.

Yield per hectare: 3t

### *Spinach – Green Wonder*



A multi-cut, late bolting variety with dark green, thick, medium large, succulent foliage. Excellent cooking quality and rich in dry matter content, protein, carotenes, Vitamin C, phosphorus and potassium.

Yield per hectare: 15t

### *Tomato – Red Plum*



This variety produces medium-large fruits (80-90 grams) that are oblate with a light green shoulder. It adapts to both rain-fed and irrigated conditions. A farmer-friendly variety; excellent for kitchen gardens.

Yield per hectare: 35t

### *Okra- Clemson Spineless*



Highly vigorous variety that may grow up to 1m. The fruits are deep-green, smooth, pointed and slightly ribbed. They are 15 - 18 cm long. Winter variety.

Yield per hectare: 10t
